Treasurer Report read and approved.

Old Business

Target Audit went well. Findings were: not everyone counting Xs (inner Tens). Only other issues were addition/counting errors. (below needs to be discussed at the executive committee)

Note I could not find any rule on how to count/score Xs or inner tens on the NRA 50 target. I also found which gauge should be used when.

NRA Smallbore rule book (which cover the NRA 50 and 3 position shooting)

14.3a Inner scoring is does as follows: The higher value with be allowed in cases where the flange of the gauge touches the scoring ring. Inward gauge must be within the following limits: 2.225-2.240 inches (5.65-5.69 mm). (NRA /USAS-50 Target – 10-ring (dot scoring): Using an inward gauge, the 10-ring (dot) must be totally covered by the inward gauge to score "10".

14.3b Outward scoring is done as follows: For the all 10 dot shots the outward gauge (scoring away for the center) will be used to determine the value close shot values 10 through 6. Outward gauges must be within the following limits: .3555 - .3535 inches (9.03 – 8.98mm).

14.3f Center shots -.... Center shots are not scored on the NRA/USAS-50 targets).....

14.3.2 Scoring Inner Tens

Per NRA International Rules – not used at the 50 ft target. Tie breaker are listed in the rule 15.4

15.4

- a. Highest ranking score in standing
- b. Highest number of inner tens in the standing position. (interesting as it does not say what an inner ten is)
- c. By the highest score on the last numbered bullseye, in the standing position
- d. By inner tens on the last numbered bullseye, in the standing position

e. By the highest ranking score on each bullseye applied in the reverse order from the last to the first in the standing position. If still a tie, apply b through e to the kneeling, then prone position.

Additional note Rule 14.3 How to score

14.3 b Note: All shots on the NRA/USAS-50 target will be scored with the outward plug(9.03-8.98) except 3s, 4s, and 5s that will be scored with the inward plug (5.60-5.65).

New Business

Discussion on the funds remaining for in the Treasure account. We need to find out why the NRA fees (\$3101) were not lower this year per the new change in fee schedule. Was it because the league was registered in 2010?

Motion: (Tom Daniel, 2nd Sandy Daniel) After finding out the expected NRA fees for the 2012 IERPA league and calculating approximate gain or loss amount using same expense the executive committee will propose one of the following to get the level to a positive amount above the \$ 634.13 Junior fund level.

- 1. Leave the fees current as of 2011 year.
- 2. Increase the Team entry fee to \$25.
- 3. Increase the individual shooter fee to \$10 instead of \$7.

The individual award metals are expected to increase from \$8.00 to \$8.50 in 2012. (this increased cost was not passed on to us this year by the trophy shot). Discussion about changing metals was covered, however due to the good quality of the metals we recommended not making a change.

Columbia match bulletin needs to be changed for the new NRA 50/USAS Target versus the A36. And changing the address to Sandpoint Range, 114 Lake Street, Sandpoint, ID 83864 (giving it a physical address).

Jean Foster shot 2 400 (one 38Xs and one 39Xs) scores. This accomplishment also broke Bernice McKinney's total point record (3973) by 3 points -3976.
